

Reflections on Writing Paper

For your second paper this summer, take a look at chapter three in *Subject & Strategy*. Read all of the essays and then pick one you would prefer to write about. Your assignment is to summarize that essay, explaining the ideas that you found most interesting or useful, and how they relate to your own writing experience. Make sure you are writing about all three of these aspects.

This essay must be organized with an introductory paragraph that includes a thesis statement and plan of development, at least three paragraphs in the body of the essay, and a concluding paragraph. Your essay must be **1,000 words** and developed with specific ideas. Please use MLA citation format (if you have questions ask me).

Make sure your paper is typed, double spaced, titled, and page numbers are inserted in the top right corner (lastname\_pagelnumber).

If you are submitting a rough draft to me, please submit your draft to my email by Monday August 9<sup>th</sup>. I will not examine late drafts! Your papers will be due to my email (professorwend@gmail.com) by 11:59pm on Friday August 13<sup>th</sup>.
